

# Troop Camping Packing List

## Clothing

Closed-toed, closed-heeled shoes (2)

- Suitable for hiking in rocky terrain; shoes not meeting this requirement may not be worn around camp

Warm sweater and/or sweatshirt (1)

Pants and/or shorts (3 total)

T-shirts (2)

- No tank tops – sleeves provide sun protection

Long sleeved shirt (1)

Underwear (3)

Socks (3)

Rain Gear (waterproof jacket or poncho)

Warm pajamas (1)

Hat with brim (1)

Bandana (optional)

Knit hat (recommended – especially for Camp Cloud Rim)

Warm coat (recommended – especially for Camp Cloud Rim)

## Camp Gear

### Trefoil Ranch – Horseback Riding:

- Long pants with no holes (jeans recommended)
- Camp will provide riding boots

### Cloud Rim Waterfront:

- Swimming suit (optional for polar bear dip)
- Towel for the waterfront
- Water Shoes (optional – must have a heel strap; camp has extra available if needed)

Sleeping bag (20 degrees or cooler)

Sheet (recommended to cover mattress)

Pillow

Warm blanket (recommended)

24-32 ounce durable water bottle

Plate/bowl, spoon, and cup for cookouts

Sunglasses

Flashlight with new batteries

Backpack (suitable to carry daily items: water bottle, sweatshirt, etc.)

SWAPS

## Toiletries *(It is helpful if toiletries are in an easy-to-carry bag)*

Toothbrush & toothpaste

Hairbrush/comb

Deodorant

Lip Balm

Sunscreen (SPF 30+)

Insect repellent

Sanitary supplies

Medications

## Optional Items

Camera (not a cellphone)

Pen/pencil

Stuffed animal

Book

Trading Post (Camp Store) money or Activity Credits

Travel games/cards

Theme week items

## Items to Leave at Home

Candy, gum, food, or soda

Curling irons, blow dryers, straighteners

Items packaged in glass containers

Cell phones (including watches with calling capabilities)

Electronic devices (tablets, smart watches, music players, etc.)

Personal sports equipment

No drugs, weapons, alcohol, or contraband of any kind

Pets or other Animals

*Electronic items can easily be damaged in the camp environment. If a camper brings these items to camp, they will be labeled and put in the Camp Director's possession until the camper checks out.*
